GOLD American style IPA packed full of hops.

● Bexley (Erith, London: 2014)

▶ BOB 4.2%

AMBER Juicy malts and peaty hop finish.

● Boot (Repton, Derbys: 2015)

▶ Clodhopper 3.9%

PALE Good malt base, caramel and bitterness at the end.

● Bradford (Bradford, W. Yorks 2015)

▶ Death Cookie 5.7%

GOLD Dry and bitter with earthy hoppiness.

● Canopy (Herne Hill, London: 2014)

▶ Brockwell 5.6%

GOLD Full-bodied, fruity malt and citrus hops.

● Cheeky Imp (Waddington, Lincs: 2015)

▶ Olde Yeller 4.6%

GOLD Brewed with topaz, cascade & galaxy hops. Sweet malt and smooth bitterness.

● Carlisle (Cummersdale, Cumbria: 2013)

▶ Herkules 4.8%

PALE Crisp, dry and refreshing. Lager-style.

● Chadwick's (Kendal, Cumbria: 2014)

▶ Galaxy 4.2%

PALE Crisp, dry, citrus hops and very bitter.

● Drygate (Glasgow: 2014)

▶ Pale Duke 4.0%

PALE Light roast, slight caramel, soft citrus hops.

● Hopcraft/Crafty Devil collab (Pontyclun, Mid Glam: 2010)

▶ Dance With the Devil 5.1%

RED Sweet malts, big on hops and good bitter finish.

● Idle Vally (Retford, Notts: 2014)

▶ Cluster Bum ESB 5.6%

AMBER One-off special casked for this festival. Spicy and floral ESB dry hopped with Cluster.

● Inkspot (London: 2014)

▶ EIPA 5.6%

GOLD Crisp and dry, bitter and well-hopped.

● Lion Heart (Longford, West Mids: 2014)

▶ Amber 4.0%

AMBER Malty, earthy and fruity with a mellow finish.

● North Riding (Scarborough, N. Yorks: 2011)

▶ Azacca 3.8%

PALE *Crisp and refreshing, hoppy with an earthy finish. From the new brewery.*

● Otherton (Cuckoo at Offbeat) (Penkridge, Staffs: 2014)

▶ Flying Dutchman 5.3%

DARK BROWN *Dark roast initially with big hop hit to follow.*

● Parker (Southport, Lancs: 2014)

▶ Dark Spartan Stout 5.0%

BLACK *Dark roast and smooth bitterness.*

● Rowett (North Thoresby, Lincs: 2014)

▶ Six Hour Lunch 3.7%

COPPER *Malty and zesty traditional session bitter.*

● Sunbeam (Leeds, W. Yorks: 2012)

▶ Chocolate Mild 4.9%

BROWN *Smooth and malty, full of choccy goodness.*

● Truman's (London: 2013)

▶ Zephyr 4.4%

AMBER *Malty session bitter.*

● Vocation (Crag Vale, W. Yorks: 2010)

▶ Bread & Butter 3.8%

PALE *Crisp and dry, mega-hopped with sherbet notes.*
